- Adopted in February 2015
- Opt-out policy
- Submission form for depositing work into OpenBU



Symplectic Elements by Digital Science

- Branded as My CV at BU
- Implemented in 2017
- Five years' worth of publications
- Metadata crosswalk to the repository



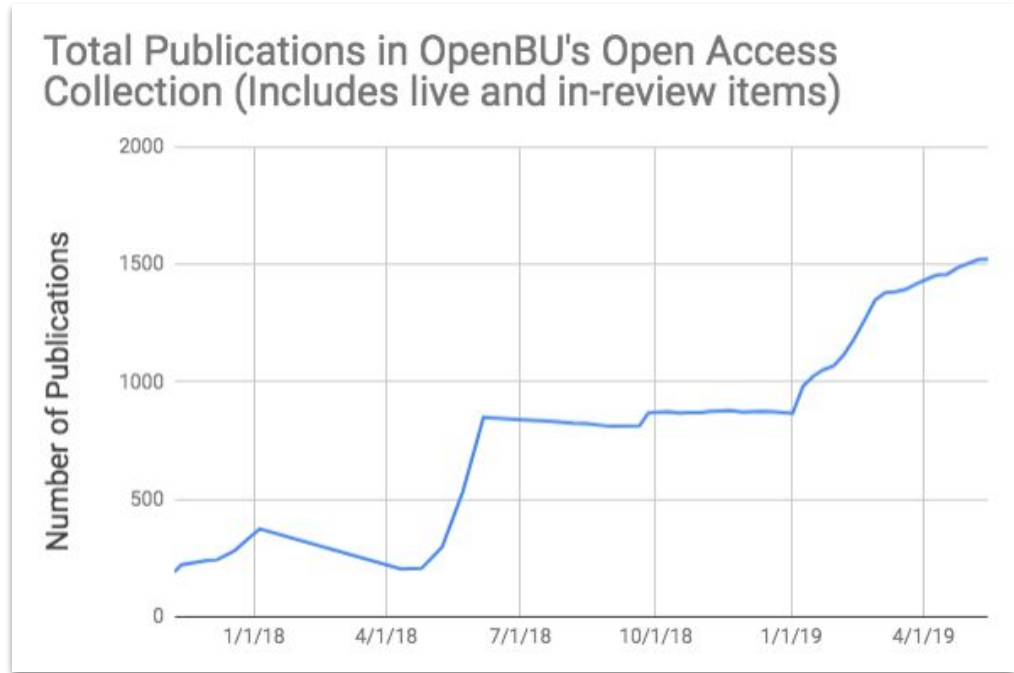


Open Access Monitor

- Implemented in 2018
- Identifies publications in OA Policy
- Email feature to contact faculty authors
