The Graduate School of Nursing Papers documents the establishment of the Graduate School of Nursing and chronicles its early history and development.

Biographical / Historical Note:

The Graduate School of Nursing (GSN) at the University of Massachusetts Medical School in Worcester, Massachusetts was established in 1985 in response to an increased need nationally for advanced practice nursing professionals. Under the leadership of the GSN's first Dean, Kathleen M. Dirschel, Ph.D., the school's curriculum was developed. It offered a Master's in Nursing Science with specialties in Ambulatory Clinical Nurse Specialist, Acute Care Clinical Nurse Specialist, and Nurse Administrator (a joint MSN/MBA with Clark University). The first class of students matriculated in 1986 and in the spring of 1987 thirteen students in the accelerated, one-year program graduated. The following year the National League for Nursing awarded the GSN full accreditation for eight years.

In 1991 Lillian R. Goodman, EdD, RN became interim Dean and was appointed permanent Dean in 1995, a position she held until her retirement in 2000. During her tenure many new programs were established including the first PhD in Nursing Program in the University of Massachusetts (UMass) system. This collaborative program with the UMass Amherst campus began in 1994 ... until 2005 when the GSN Worcester campus began an independent PhD program. Additional programs added during the 1990s include Cardiac Nursing, Geriatric Nursing, Cancer Prevention and Control Education, and HIV/AIDS subspecialties.

Doreen C. Harper, PhD, RN, FAAN, was appointed Dean in 2000. Several new programs were developed during her deanship including the Adult Nurse Practitioner/Gerontological Nurse Practitioner and Acute Critical Care Nurse Practitioner/Gerontological Nurse Practitioner dual track specialties. Two other programs, the Worcester Nursing Pipeline Consortium and the Graduate Entry Pathway (GEP), were created during this time to address the increased nursing shortage.

Named interim Dean in 2005 and appointed Dean in 2006, Paulette Seymour-Route, PhD, RN, a graduate of GSN, oversaw the beginning of the independent PhD in Nursing Program and the graduation of the first students in the GEP program. In 2008 the Doctorate in Nursing Practice (DNP) Program was approved and its first class of students accepted. The first student in the BS-to-PhD Program was also accepted in 2008. In 2010 the first National Institutes of Health (NIH) R01 and R21 grants were awarded to the GSN.

Scope and Content: This collection contains material relating to the establishment and development of the Graduate School of Nursing at the University of Massachusetts Medical School in Worcester, Massachusetts from 1982 through 2009. The collection consists of correspondence, reports, planning documents, publications, news clippings, and photographs that chronicle the activities of the Graduate School of Nursing community.
